### **Timeline for SCNATS Spring 2023 Classical/Spiritual Auditions**

January 12	Registration for ALL SCNATS Spring categories opens
January 26	Registration for ALL SCNATS Spring categories closes <b>and</b> Children and Youth (C/Y) Videos due
February 2	Any repertoire changes (not C/Y) are due to VP email ( <a href="mailto:odom@clemsun.edu">odom@clemsun.edu</a> )
February 2 – 4	Adjudication of C/Y Videos
February 6	C/Y Regional qualifiers and HR recipients announced
February 11	In person SCNATS auditions for all categories (except C/Y) and in person Honors Recital for <b>all</b> categories including C/Y

As you are planning your spring repertoire, remember that our Spotlight on African American Composers awards for one high school student and one collegiate/adult student will again be offered this spring. Your students may also enter the Hall Johnson Spirituals category and the American Negro Spirituals categories in SCNATS this spring, but only the American Negro Spirituals will advance to Regionals and NSA this year.
